Did you know that CACCI was founded in August 1985 as a statewide membership and small business resource organization? CACCI membership is open to all persons of diverse backgrounds who are willing to adhere to CACCI's Mission. *Membership Business Networking Power Breakfast Meetings* bring members together to meet, network and do business with each other and with the wider business community.

Did you know that CACCI has developed expertise in providing business assistance to small businesses in business planning, financing, certification preparation, expansion, and on doing business in the Caribbean? CACCI's extensive track record of service delivery, established partnerships with government and private sectors have enabled the organization to survive and thrive for 23 years.

Did you know that for the past 2 decades CACCI has hosted CARICOM Heads of Government and international trade delegations on their visits to New York.? CACCI has conducted trade missions to the Caribbean focusing on trade and investment, health, mental health and disaster relief.

Did you know that CACCI is developing the first ever Caribbean Trade Center in New York?

This project is a 28,000 sq. ft building located in a major commercial corridor adjacent to one of NYC historic educational institutions, Erasmus High School, in the East Flatbush Section of Brooklyn, New York. Upon completion, this landmark building will serve as CACCI's headquarters, house major anchor tenants, offer fee-for-service domestic and international business services, and create jobs.

Did you know that CACCI manages and operates the Flatbush Caton Merchants Mart (FCMM)? The FCMM is a 9,000 sq. ft. micro-enterprise incubator, an indoor shopping mall in the Flatbush section of Brooklyn with over 40 vendors who sell a variety of African and Caribbean artifacts.

Did you know that CACCI provides MWBE Certification Preparation business services for Minority and Women-owned Business Enterprises (MWBE)? The Caribbean American Chamber Of Commerce and Industry, Inc (CACCI) continues to be part of New York City's effort to attract women and minority-owned small business owners (M/WBE) and helps them to become certified by the City Of New York so that they can enhance their business growth and development.

Did you know that CACCI launched a Financial Literacy Initiative targeted to youth, seniors, faith-based groups, small business owners? CACCI conducts a series of Small Business Workshops on Credit, Cash Flow, Insurance, Budgeting, Real Estate Mortgages, Homeownership and Asset Protection.
